

JUST DO IT!

"Don't Judge Others!"



"God Is The Judge And I AM NOT!"



"Do not judge, or you too will be judged." - Matthew 7:1

SAY:

Have you ever known someone who was SO BAD that you thought, "They could NEVER become a Christian!"? OR have you ever known someone who had done so many sinful things that you thought, "That person sure does deserve some punishment!"?

Well, that's exactly what the Pharisees thought when they brought the woman to Jesus in today's Bible Story.

READ:

John 8:1-11

DISCUSS:

- Who brought the woman to Jesus in our Bible Story?
- What did The Pharisees want to do with the woman?
- What did Jesus do in the dirt?
- What did The Pharisees do with their rocks?

SAY:

This woman had been caught sinning. She had a bad reputation, and everyone seemed to know that she was guilty of sin. The Pharisees brought her before Jesus, and they planned to "stone" her.

We must not be a "rock thrower," judging others, but a "grace giver" instead. Jesus commanded us, "Do not judge!" We must obey His command!

PRAY:

Pray for your children who might have been guilty of judging others and "throwing rocks" at others. Pray that they will remember they are sinners, too. Pray they will receive forgiveness for their sins (including judging others) and choose to be a "grace giver" like Jesus.
